



# St. Lawrence Seaway Trip

## Sept 3-6, 2009



### The Accommodations

We'll stay with our friends at Caigers Resort, located right on the river in Mallorytown, Ontario, and convenient to all the great dive sites. Rooms are double occupancy, nothing fancy, but the staff is great and the restaurant serves up some fine food and cold beverages!

### The Diving

Diving in the upper St. Lawrence River can be many things. From shallow shipwrecks to 200 foot granite walls the waters between Kingston Ontario and Montreal Quebec has every thing a fresh water diver could ask. The river was the freeway of yesterday that supplies to build two countries were delivered on. Many ships have gone to the bottom, leaving us time capsules to explore. Join us for another long weekend of great diving on the wrecks of the St. Lawrence Seaway. This time of the year the water is near 80 degrees and the visibility is phenomenal. From our resort it is just a short hop on the boat to our dive sites. The wrecks are plentiful and most are intact, making for some very cool dives.



And as you have grown to expect, IVS is doing things a little different on this trip. For starters, on Saturday will likely be a 5-tanker, as we'll dive the King Horn, then clear U.S. Customs, and spend the rest of the day in America, diving the Vickery, lunch ashore in A-Bay, then dive the America and Kinghorn wrecks, with a nice night drift dive along Singer island, and cocktails on board as we return. Sunday we'll do a 4-tank trip, diving all Canadian wrecks, eliminating the need for a second border crossing and all the fun that goes along with that. We expect to visit the Daryaw, Muscellunge, enjoy lunch on board, then hit the Gaskins and Lillie Parsons wrecks before apres-dive cocktails and the ride back to the resort.

And as an option, technical divers can stay with us on Monday as we head out to dive the Jodrey (140-200 ft) , de-gas with a BBQ lunch ashore, and jump back in for a drift dive along Wallace Gorge (170 ft). Join Team IVS for this technical expedition to visit the deeper wrecks of the St. Lawrence Seaway. See what so few have seen since the day these ships sunk. Trimix certification is recommended for this envelope-pushing experience.

We have two days of recreational diving planned, and an option for a third day of more technical diving on some of the deeper wrecks in the area, so there are activities for everyone!

### The Package:

- Three nights lodging at Caigers Resort, double occupancy
- Two days of recreational diving on American & Canadian wrecks (up to 9 dives!)
- An optional third day of technical diving (2 dives)
- Divers must provide their own gear and tanks (rentals available on site if needed)
- Gas fills are available nearby and not included in the package price
- Gratuities not included.

### Cost:

\$590.00 per person for recreational package

Add \$160.00 for Tec Diving Add-On
