Marine Life Injuries & On-Site Neuro Combined Program

Program #HST.005



Serious hazardous marine life injuries are rare, but most divers experience minor discomfort from unintentional encounters with fire coral, jellyfish and other marine creatures. The first part of this course teaches divers to minimize the risk of these injuries, and in the event of an encounter, to reduce diver discomfort, pain and the potential for permanent injury.

Part II of this program focuses on learning how to conduct a neurological assessment on a potentially injured diver in this course. The information gained in this assessment can help the rescuer convince an injured diver of the need for oxygen first aid, and to help a dive physician determine the course of proper treatment.
