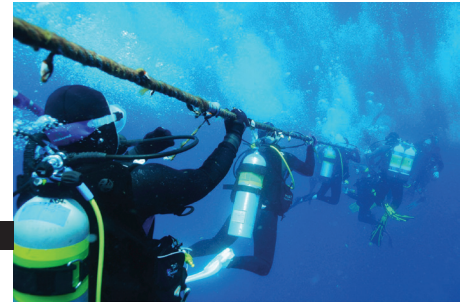




Course Overview
