THE LODGING AND THE AREA

Visiting the town of Alexandria Bay is like a mini-vacation in itself. The downtown strip is alive with great eateries, live musical venues, plenty of touristy things, and history to boot! It's worth a ride up even if you weren't diving...but what fun is that?

Our lodging will be in one of the local hotels along the river, convenient to walk downtown but far enough away to let you sleep at night. Free parking, good security, and easy access tour diving all make your stay a pleasant one.

THE DIVING

The St. Lawrence Seaway has been a vital shipping channel for 100 years, connecting the Great Lakes to the Atlantic Ocean and the world. While it boasts depths to 400 feet, it also has narrow channels and lots of rocky outcroppings to avoid. Due to the constant outflow from the Great Lakes the current tends to run strong, sometimes crazy-strong, especially when influenced by bottom structure or any of the thousands of islands that dot the waterway. As a result, hundreds of ships of all sizes have met their demise while sailing along the St. Lawrence, and lie in wait for our exploration at depths ranging from 20 ft to over 300 ft.

Thanks to the constant flow of water, and the slightly lower temperatures, the Seaway supports a bit of invasive life, such as Belgian Gobies and Zebra Mussels. It also does not support nasty species such as Wood-Boring Worms, which tend to turn most wrecks into dust in a short period of time. As a result, the wrecks are in pristine shape, even 100 years after succumbing to thier the watery graves. Many have a lot of history to them, and often tragedies, but they all make wonderful sites on which to dive and explore.

While the water of the Great Lakes averages about 39 degrees, thankfully, the St. Lawrence is a balmy 65 to 70 degrees when we dive it in the summer months. Wetsuits of 5 mm suffice for most divers, along with a hood and gloves.

Trust us...you will love North Carolina wreck diving!
