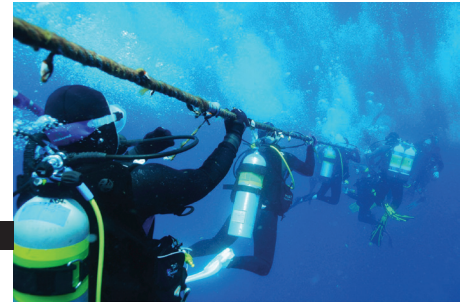




## Course Overview
