benefits and enjoyment of multilevel diving with PADI's eRDP/ML dive planner and/or with modern dive computers.

You'll learn what multilevel diving is and why you want to plan for multilevel dives. You'll also get to see the various types of multilevel dive calculators (including the Recreational Dive Planner-Wheel version and dive computers), as well as learn about multilevel dive planning, organization, procedures, techniques, and potential problems.

Your Adventures In Diving Multilevel Adventure Dive will count towards the Specialty certification. And, completion of the Specialty certification counts as one of five Specialty certifications necessary for your Master Scuba Diver certification.
