PADI's Search and Recovery Diver Specialty course will teach you effective ways to find objects underwater and safely bring them to the surface. Small, large or just awkward, there is a safe and proper way to bring them up.

During this course you will be introduced to the many tools and specialty piece of equipment that are utilized for effective search and recovery efforts. You'll learn search and recovery dive planning, organization, procedures, techniques and potential problems. You'll also cover limited visibility diving, search patterns and safe object recovery using lift devices.

Your Adventures In Diving Search and Recovery Adventure Dive may count toward this Specialty certification. Completion of this specialty also counts as one of five Specialty certifications required for your Master Scuba Diver certification.
