You'll learn the basics of underwater photography such as composition, program setup, and camera handling, with special emphasis on practical techniques. You'll learn underwater photography dive planning, organization, procedures, techniques and potential problems. You'll also learn how to care for and maintain your camera equipment.

Completion of this specialty certification also counts toward one of the five Specialties required for your Master Scuba Diver certification.
