



# BLUE HERON BRIDGE World Class Diving and Sharks too!

#### ...A VERY DIFFERENT SORT OF TRIP...

So very often, a dive trip sometimes feels like a bit of a manic marathon, with lots of early morning rising, racing to the dock to sign in and catch the boat, and finally, a chance to explore the beauty under the sea that inspired us to come in the first place. Well our Blue Heron Bridge weekend is just the opposite of that!



Easy to get to, and ranked as one of the top shore diving sites in the U.S., the waters that flow under the bridge provide homes for an amazing variety of critters, large, small and tiny. While more tending to be towards the smaller side (no Goliath Groupers or Whale Sharks here!) the array of colors, shapes, and designs will truly blow you away. Tropicals of all sorts, juveniles, crustaceans, nudibranchs, squid, octopus, rays, - you name it, you have a great chance of finding it here. Along with a few dozen shopping carts and the other inevitable bits of man-made reef structures that somehow manage to fall into the water, but today they are providing homes and hideaways for all sorts of critters. With a maximum depth of about 20 feet, you'll get about two hours of bottom time off an 80 CF tank, so you certainly won't run out of time on your dives. Eeezy peeezy shore entry, loads of tropicals and muck dwellers, two hour bottom times, 85 degree water temp....tough to beat!

Once we've had our share of little critter sightings, we'll head over to Jupiter Dive Center and complete our paperwork while we get the lay of the land for Friday's dives. A great operation with a nice, comfortable dive boat, we'll spend all day doing a 3-tank dive trip with lunch onboard at several offshore sites on Saturday.

Saturday we really amp up the adrenaline as we head out with another one of our favorite operators, Emerald Charters, and Capt. Randy Jordan. This a all-big-critter day, with huge Goliath Groupers, and lots of hungry, interactive sharks joining us on the wrecks, looking for the handouts offered by the Emerald crew. Wide angle lenses and bright strobes are the order of the day here to capture some amazing memories.
